

IDCTA Spring Dressage Clinician Jochen Hippenstiel

May 1 & 2, 2010

Eagle Lake Equestrian Center in Peotone, IL



Jochen Hippenstiel was the head trainer of the Tempel Lipizzans from 2002 through 2009. During that time, he has coached one of the most winning groups of riders at the USDF Region 2 Regional Dressage Championships. He coached Katie Hamilton to a team gold at the North American Young Rider's Championship in 2005 and took her to compete at the first Young Rider World Cup Competition in Germany. Throughout his coaching career, Hippenstiel has trained more than 15 horses to Grand Prix, including Adrett, ridden by Pia Laus for Italy in two Olympics and two World Cup competitions.

Junior and young rider teams coached by Hippenstiel in Germany also won numerous regional and national titles in the 1980s. During his six years as national coach for Luxembourg (1992-1998), the country's teams repeatedly qualified for the European Championships and Hippenstiel-coached senior rider Pierre Rossy progressed to the 1998 World Equestrian Games in Rome. Jochen is one of only a few equestrians in the world to be recognized as a member of the International Dressage Trainer Club. Jochen and Sarah Hippenstiel's Dressage International is now based out of the Double Lucky Ranch in Wadsworth, IL. Jochen is an excellent instructor and can help you reach your dressage goals. Jochen will work with riders of all levels. Clinic information is below and on www.IDCTA.org.

Rider/horse cost (two-days): \$280 for IDCTA members / \$330 for non-members, paid to IDCTA, which includes 2 – 45 minute lessons with Jochen and lunch on both days. Stabling is an additional \$30/night paid separately to Michael Smith. Riders will be selected based on levels to be filled, order of the receipt of entry, and volunteerism. Members have priority over non-members. Entries must be received no later than Wednesday, April 21st. The rider schedule will be posted on the WEB site the week of the clinic.

Auditing cost: Pre-registration is \$15/day for members, \$20/day non-members. At the door is \$25/day for members, \$30/day for non-members. Auditors can pre-register or register at the door the days of the clinic. Lunch will be provided to those that pre-register. Please complete the rider Dressage Clinic Entry Form or, to pre-register to audit, complete the IDCTA Dressage Events Audit Form, posted in the Scribe or on the WEB site ([.IDCTA.org/forms](http://IDCTA.org/forms)).
