to adults and young riders competing at all levels. The challenge is based only on your dressage score, not the final result of the event.

Freehorse Farm would like to accentuate the importance of the dressage phase and acknowledge those who are putting in their best effort and inspire others to do so in the future! If the response in the first year is good, we would like to expand on future categories of the Event Horse Dressage Challenge.

So save those dressage tests! The results will be

based on an average of five scores from any recognized horse trials during the IDCTA competition season. The scores may be from two levels as long as they are concurrent; and must be the same rider, horse pair.

Get out there and do your dressage, smile down centerline and own the ride! Freehorse Farm and Kevin Nelson, DVM will provide a beautiful prize for our first place pair and reserve champion with ribbons through sixth place. Good luck competitors!

Freehorse Farm Eventers' Dressage Challenge Report Form

All recognized Horse Trial, Three-day event and combined test scores must be submitted to IDCTA in order to be eligible. In addition, you must volunteer a minimum of 5 hours at an IDCTA activity. Rules: Fives scores are needed. Scores need to be from at least three different judges. They may be from different levels so long as they are concurrent levels.
